1. About the Open Call

Sarau, an independent curator platform, invites artists to apply for The Borders – Tokyo Edition, a 3-day exhibition at Mugen Gallery (Tokyo, Japan). This open call welcomes artists working across all disciplines: installation, photography, illustration, painting, sculpture, video art, performance art, and interdisciplinary practices. Unlike themed exhibitions, The Borders highlights cultural crossings by bringing together artists from diverse backgrounds to exhibit, share space, and connect with the Tokyo artistic community.

2. Exhibition Opportunities

Selected artists will present their works alongside the launch of the Artist Book — a collective publication by The Sarau platform. - 1 artist (in-person): invited to Tokyo. Costs covered: round-trip travel, accommodation, artwork shipping. - 2 artists (remote): artworks shipped and displayed at Mugen Gallery. Costs covered: artwork shipping.

- Application deadline: October 11, 2025 - Results announced: October 20, 2025 - Exhibition dates: November 14–16, 2025 - Venue: Mugen Gallery, Tokyo

4. Eligibility

- Open to emerging and established artists worldwide. - No age or nationality restrictions. - Collaborative groups may apply (submit as one application).

5. Submission Requirements

Submit one PDF file (max 10 MB) including: - Portfolio (2–3 pages): Selected works with descriptions, titles, medium, dimensions, year. - Exhibition Proposal (2 pages): Concept and intention for The Borders – Tokyo Edition. * Measurements, duration (for performance/video), number of works, technical needs. * Images/sketches of proposed works. * Links to video works (if applicable). Notes: - All texts in English. - Videos uploaded online (Vimeo/YouTube/Drive) with links in PDF. - File name format: Surname_Firstname_SarauTokyo2025.pdf

6. Selection Process

Applications reviewed by Sarau curators and Mugen Gallery staff. Selection based on: - Artistic quality - Relevance to the exhibition's purpose - Feasibility of production and installation
